COURSE: This 40-hour course is approved by the Florida Animal Control Association (FACA), DBA Florida Animal Protection and Advocacy Association (FAPAA), and meets the certification requirements under Florida Statute 828.27(4). Students must attend all sessions and pass the state exam with a score of 75% or higher to receive certification. Successful completion of this course is required before issuing cruelty violation citations and enhances job prospects in the animal protection field. Course registration includes all study materials, a certification of completion, and official listing in FAPAA's database as a certified Animal Control Officer.

NOTE: Students will receive FAPAA course books prior to the start of class and must agree to read and study the material prior to attending. Students must wear casual clothing; long pants and closed-toe shoes.
