Purpose of Job: To ensure safety & well-being of the Aquatic Center patrons, including surveillance of pool and surrounding areas. Provide first aid and emergency care utilizing certificate skills as needed. Assist with daily operations of the Aquatic Center.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Must communicate effectively with patrons and other staff members.
- Provide emergency care when needed.
- Provide lifeguarding for the facility and its patrons.
- Perform cleanup and maintenance of Aquatic Center pool area, equipment, locker facilities and classroom.
