- CLEP exam payments must be made by test-takers online through the **clep.collegeboard.org** before coming to the test center to take a CLEP.
- Proctor fee of \$30 can be paid the day of the test or can be paid by phone to our Student Accounts office at 386-506-3024.
- In "My Account" upon completing the registration process, each test-taker will print or bring in an
 electronic copy of the Registration Ticket and present it at the test center as proof of payment. The ticket
 will include a Ticket ID and/or a Voucher ID to be used for check-in at the test center.

Please note that at Daytona State College:

- 1. No letter grade (A, B, C) is given for credit earned through the CLEP program.
- The maximum number of credits that can be earned through the combined total of AP, IB, CLEP, DSST, BYUFLATS, APLE exam and APLE portfolio development (or any other credits by exam) is 75% of your degree or certificate program (45 credits for an AA degree).
- 3. Credit by examination may not duplicate ordinary credit, dual enrollment credit or other credits earned through examination.
- 4. CLEP requires a three (3) month waiting period for retakes of failed or stopped tests.
- 5. There is NO refund for a failed or stopped test.
- 6. CLEP official score reports will be sent to the Records Department at the college/university you select. Assessment Services does not maintain copies of CLEP score reports.
