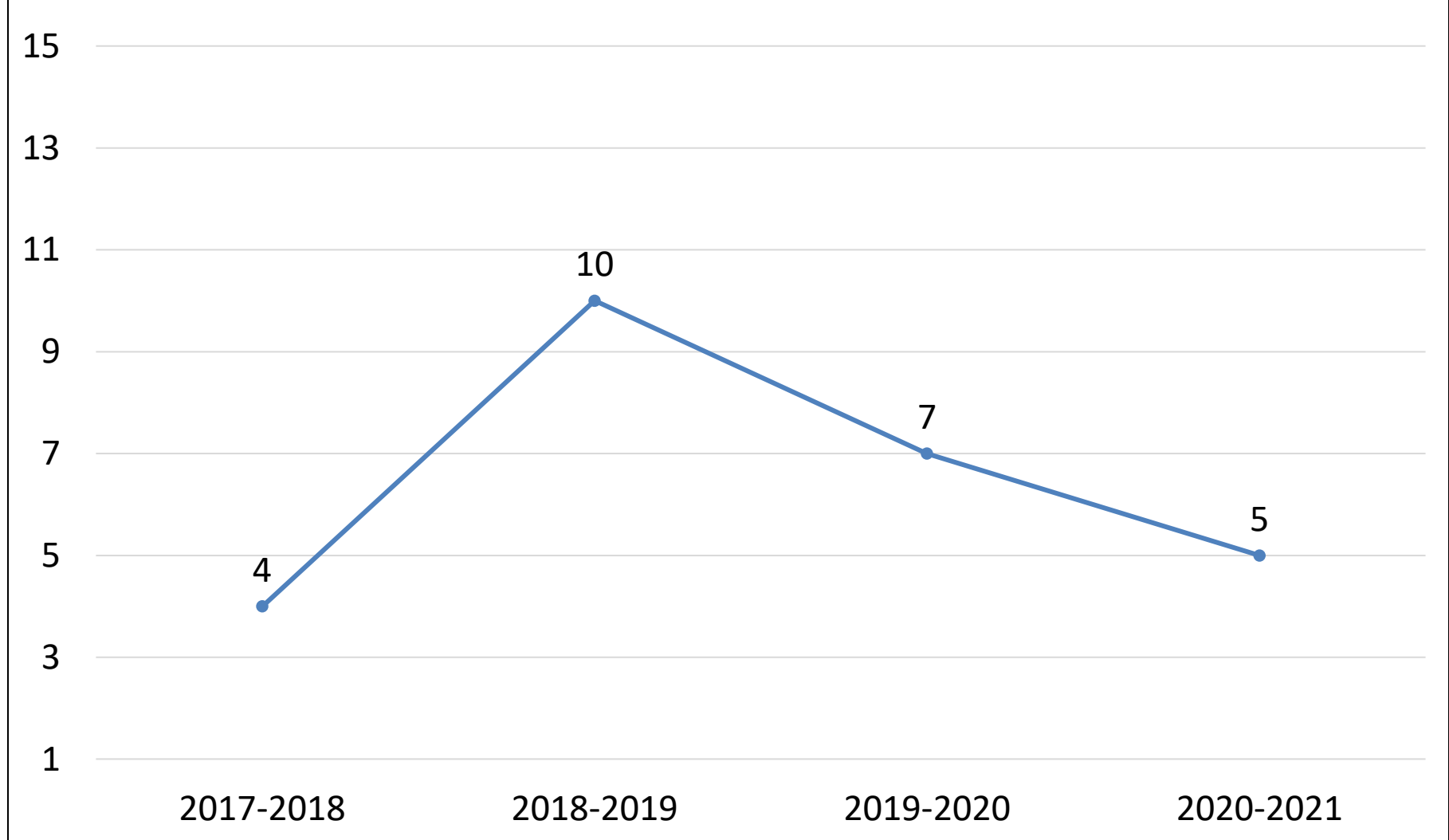

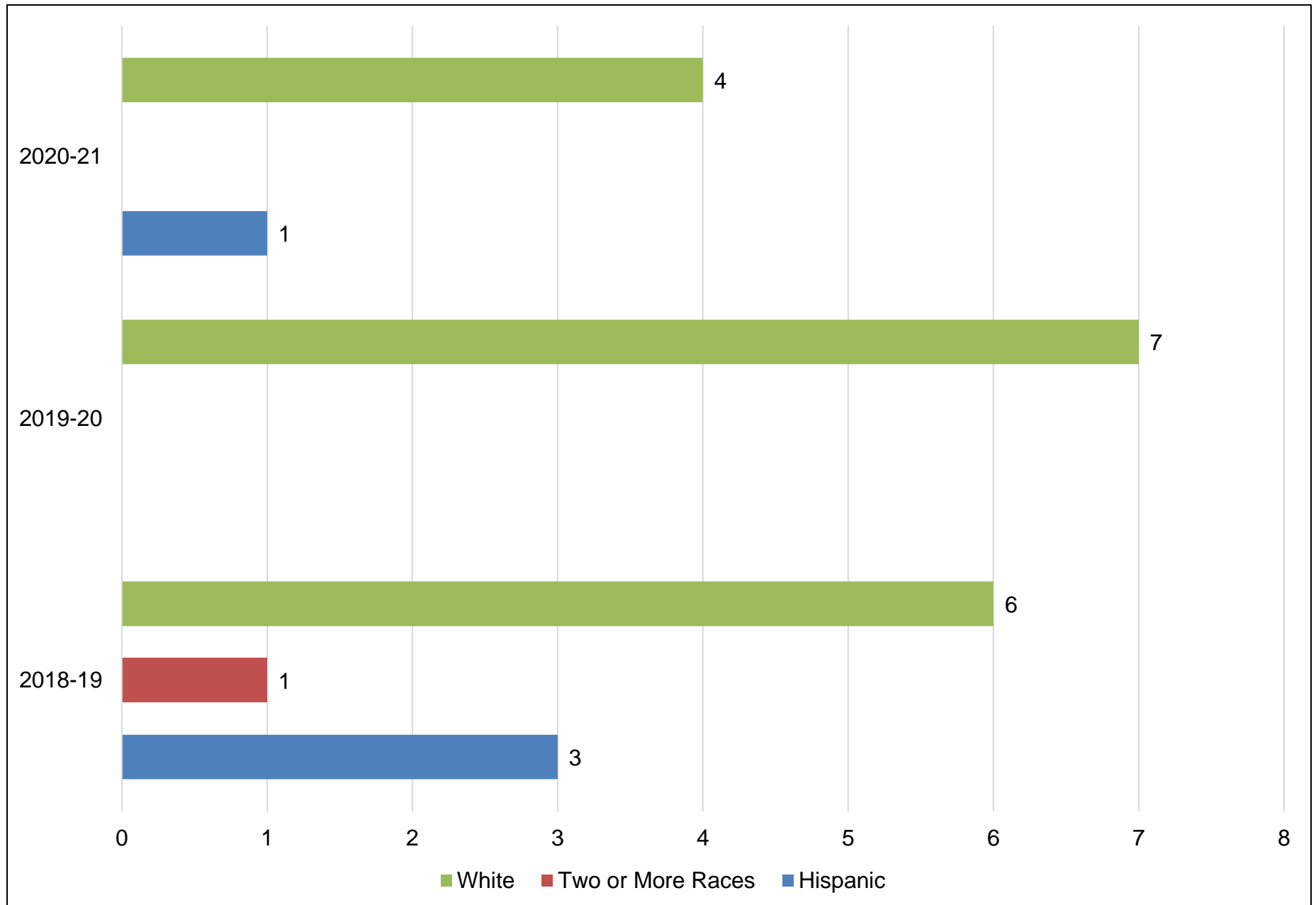
## Headcount 1072 - ELECTRICIAN APPR - UNION

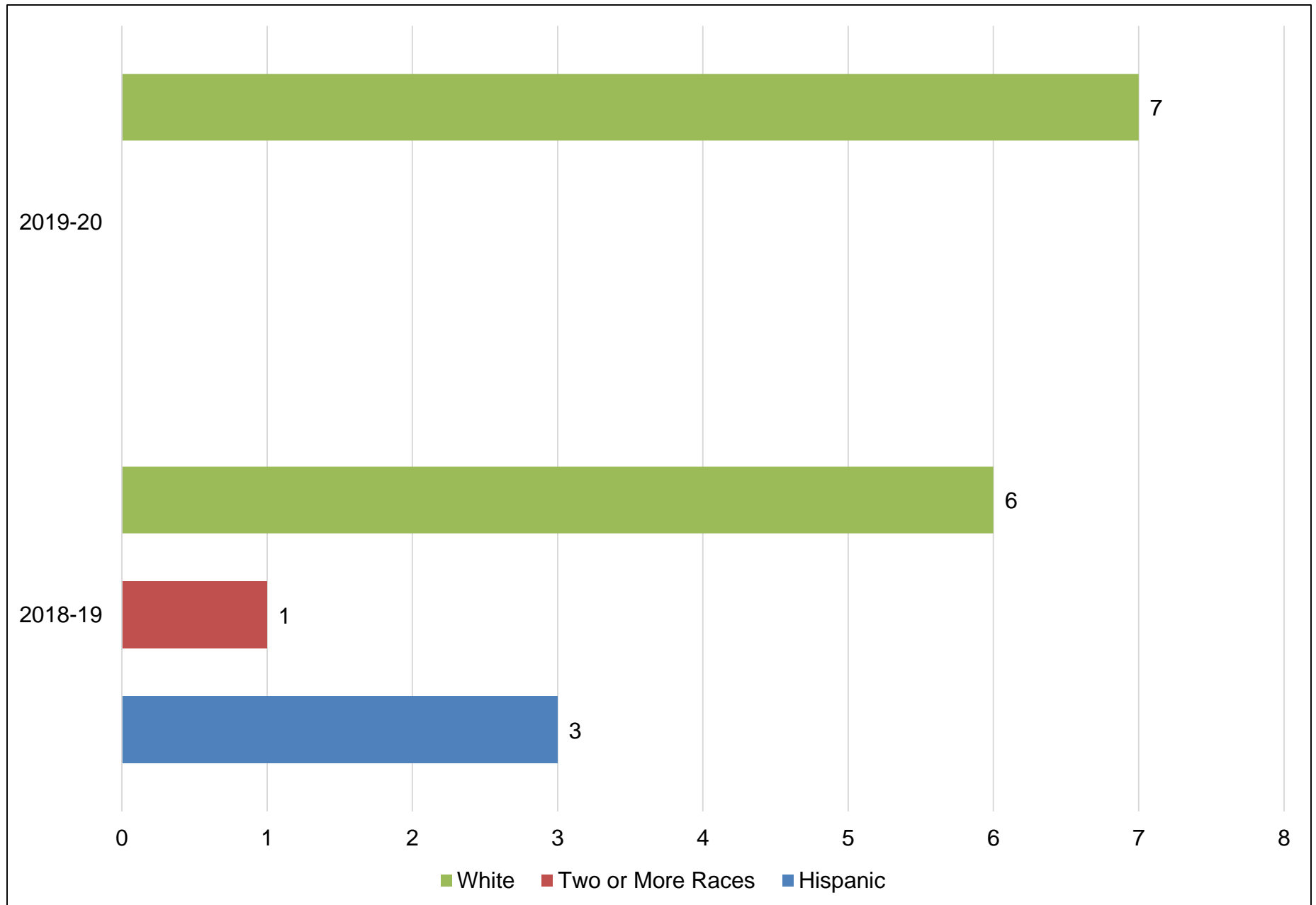

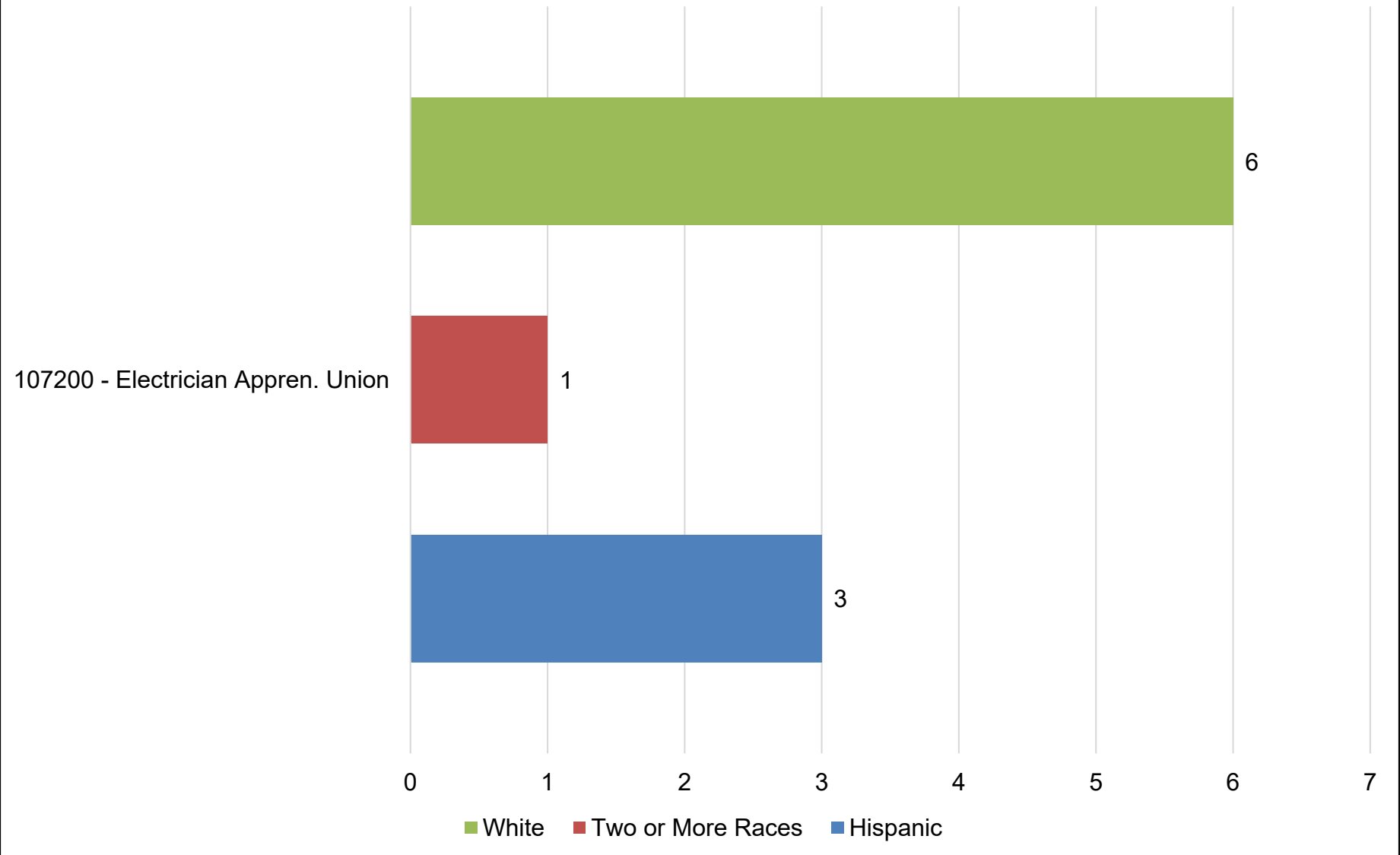


